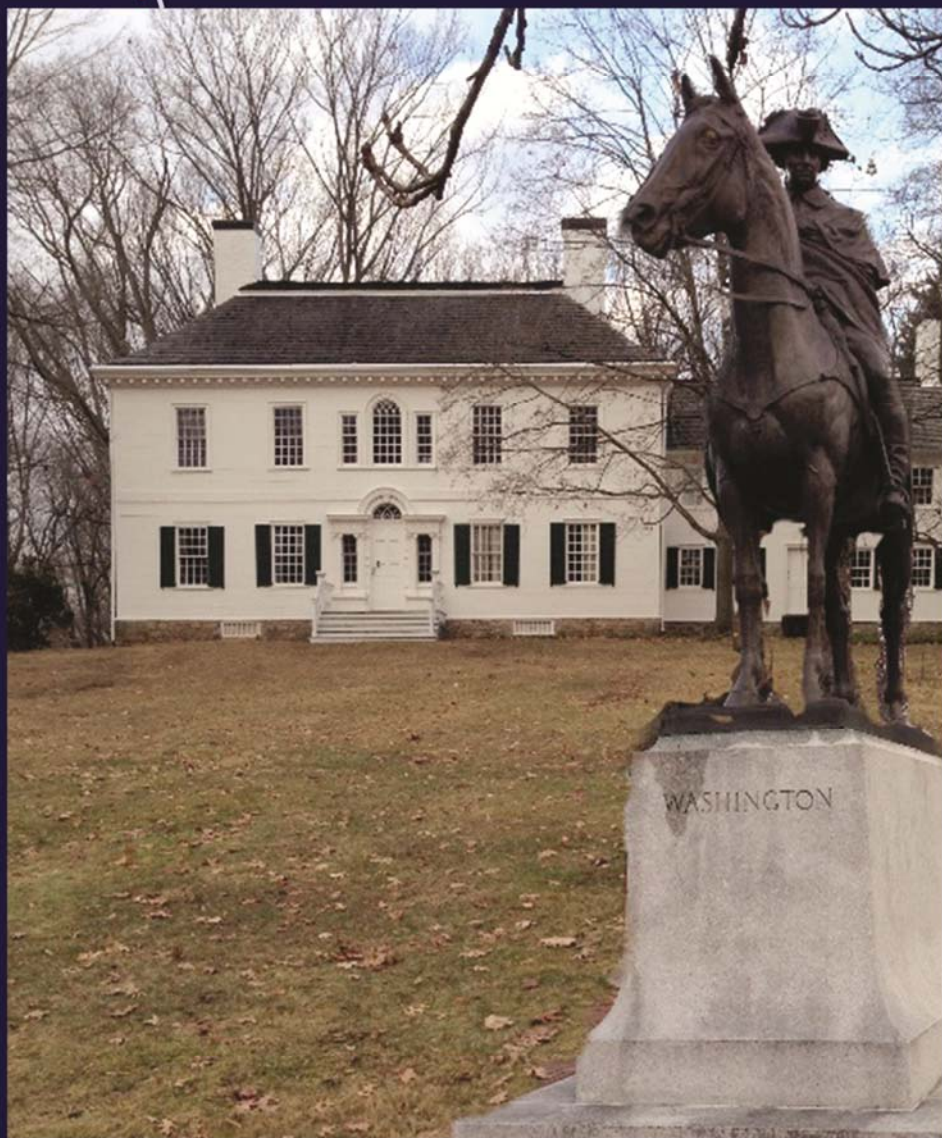

275TH ANNIVERSARY

It is said that a sheriff can rise no higher than the purpose and conscience of the individual citizen who elected them because of the required accountability. Of all the Law Enforcement agencies in the state of New Jersey, the sheriff is the only head official that is elected by the citizens. This has been a standing tradition for centuries. The importance of the elected sheriff is that he or she must be responsive and accountable to the citizens and address the ever changing needs of the community and provide support services to the municipalities.

The Morris County Sheriff's Office (MCSO) was established 37 years BEFORE the official birth of the United States of America. Back in 1739, Sheriff Thomas Clark took the oath of office as the very first MCSO sheriff. Since then, there has only been 75 others who have served as sheriff of Morris County. Currently, Sheriff Edward V. Rochford is serving his 8th three-year term and is the second longest serving sheriff in the history of the county; standing a close second to Sheriff Arnold Ladd who served 27 years, from 1947 to 1974.

There have been many great sheriffs along the way with one of the most successful sheriffs still being among us. Sheriff John Fox who served from 1975-1992, left his mark for spearheading many of today's programs. His legacy includes but is not limited to, having started the CrimeStoppers, the K-9 unit, the Bomb Squad, the Crime Scene Unit and the Sheriff's Emergency Response Team (SERT).

Under the strong and steady leadership of Sheriff Rochford, the MCSO attained national recognition in 1998, for becoming the first Sheriff's Office in the state of New Jersey to earn the distinction of being nationally accredited. And further went on to earn the Triple Crown Award which has only been attained by 34 of the 3,083 counties in the country. Sheriff Rochford and his agency currently manage an outstanding Criminal Investigation Section, Bomb Squad, 400+ inmate Correctional Facility, a Warrant Squad, a top notch Sheriff's Emergency Response Team and an eighteen dog K-9 Unit. The MCSO accepts nothing less than maintaining the highest levels of preparedness in order to protect the community at large in these uncertain times.

Rochford, and the men and women of the Sheriff's Department as they celebrate their 275th anniversary.

The Morris County Surrogate Court serves the public in administering wills, estates, and trusts of Morris County residents. The Judge of the Surrogate Court since 1994 is John Pecoraro, who presides over probating estates to manage decedents' real and personal property, and the appointment of guardians for minors.

The Morris County Surrogate Court also supports public searching for documents related to probated estates over the internet at www.morrissurrogate.com (Select *Search Probated Estates*), on public access workstations in the office of the County Clerk on the first floor of the Administration and Records Building and in the Surrogate Court on the fifth floor of the same Administration and Records Building from 8:30 A.M. to 4:30 P.M. Monday through Friday. The public can search for probate records from as early as 1804 on these workstations and, in the case of more recent records, view and print the actual contents of Surrogate Court Dockets. For older cases, searchers can identify the files they need and make copies of needed documents in the Surrogate Court.
