INTRODUCTION TO THE 2016 MORRIS COUNTY MANUAL

Welcome to our 2016 County Manual. This is the 110th year of the manual's publication by the County Clerk's Office. Since this is a Presidential election year, it is fitting that the cover page features the first President of the United States of America, President George Washington.

The County Clerk's Office shares the election process with the Board of Elections which is comprised of four Commissioners, two from each major party. They certify election results, hire and assign poll workers, count votes by mail and provisional ballots, and oversee all recounts.

I, through the Election Bureau, administer the following elections responsibilities:

1. Act as the Filing Officer for nomination petitions for County Offices (Freeholder, Clerk, Sheriff, Surrogate) and for Independent candidates (nomination by direct petition) running for County, Municipal and School Board Offices.
2. Design & print all ballot materials (Official Sample Ballots, Provisional Ballots, Voting Machine Face Ballots, Mail-In Ballots, and Emergency Ballots).
3. Publish notices of Mail-In Ballot availability and mail Official Sample Ballots.
4. Receive and review all Mail-In Ballot Applications.
5. Serve as Clerk of the County Board of Elections and issue Certificates of Election after General Election results are certified.

The right to vote is a principal responsibility of every citizen and the cornerstone of our Republic. I encourage everyone to exercise that right by participating in the Primary Election on June 7th and the General Election on November 8th. You will find other important election dates inside the back cover.

Established 277 years ago, the Clerk's Office records land records, officiates marriages, issues County and Veteran ID cards, administers and records the oaths of Notaries Public, and accepts U.S. Passport Applications.

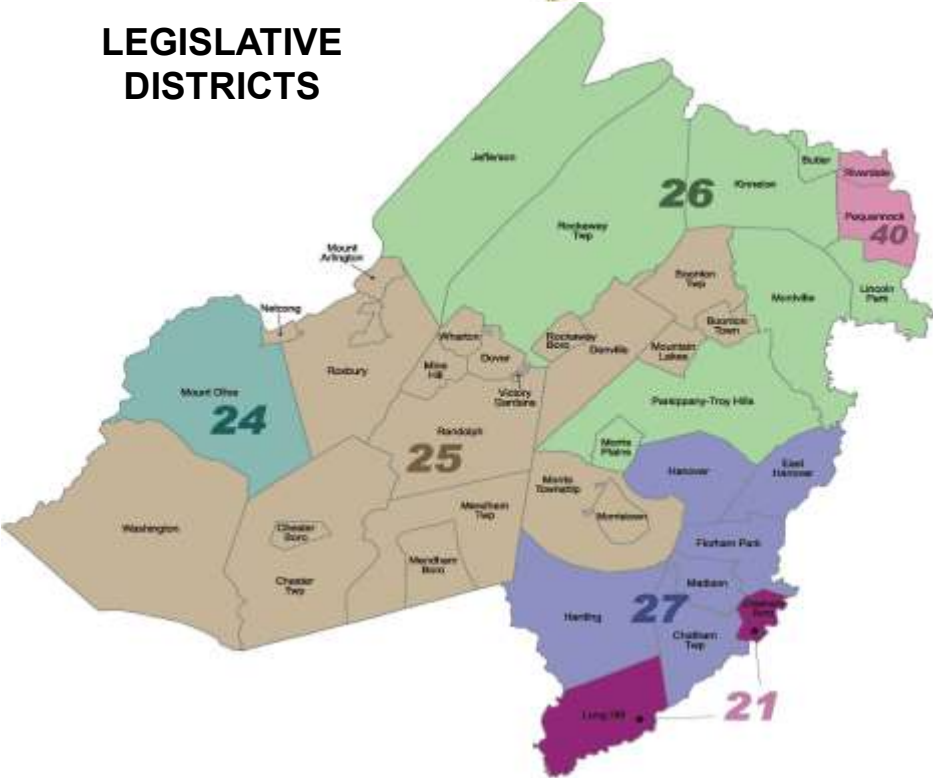

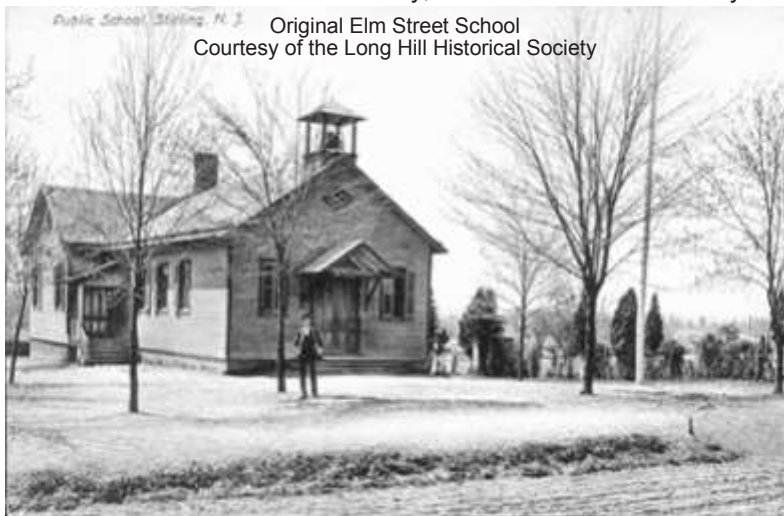
