I look forward to serving you throughout the year and I hope the Manual becomes a valuable resource for you too.

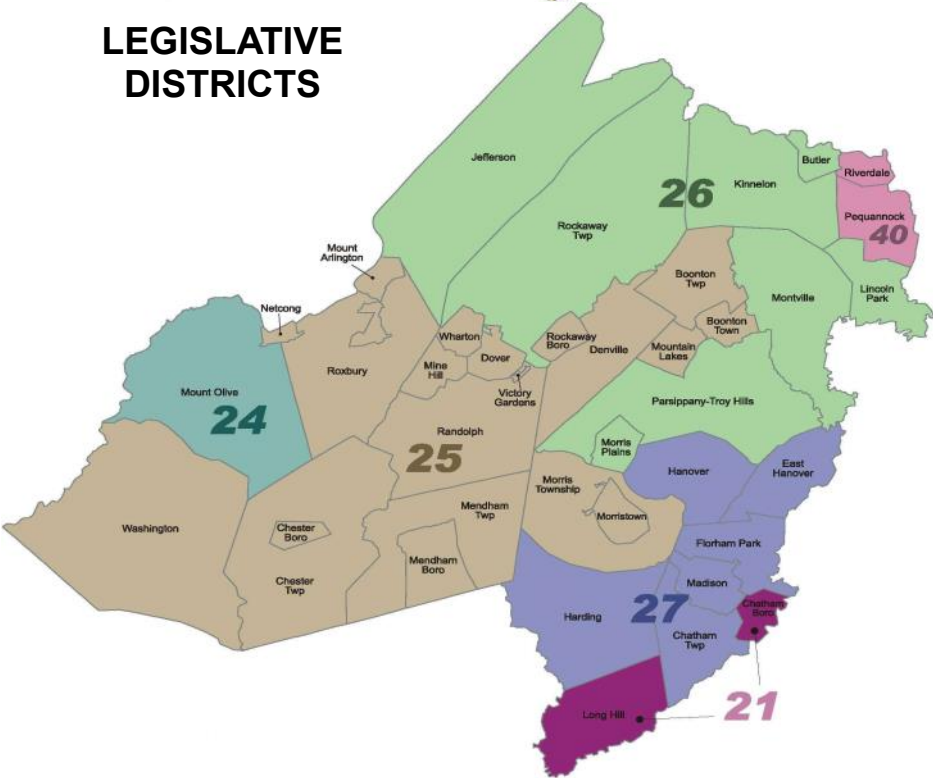

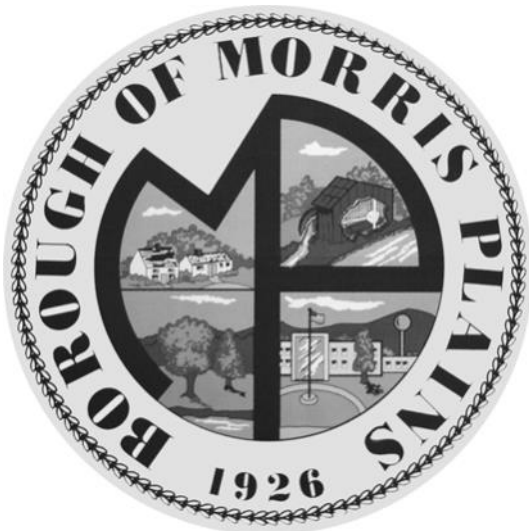
