INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

1. Please read through the instructions completely. After inserting the card given to you by the poll worker, insert it into the card slot in the device to the right, cut corner of the card in the upper right.
2. Touch **YES** or **NO** on the **PROPOSAL** to make your selection. Your selection will turn **Green**. To Change your selection, touch the **Green Box** again and it will de-select your choice. You may make a new selection.
3. When you have completed voting and verified your selection, touch the **Green "Print Ballot"** button on the lower right side of the screen. A confirmation message will first be displayed to **"Return to Ballot"** or **"Print"**.
 - To make any changes before printing the voter paper audit trail, touch **"Return to Ballot"**.
 - To proceed with printing the voter paper audit trail, touch **"Print"**
 - This will print your selection on the card and display it in the printer window for your review.
 - Review the card to ensure it represents your selection accurately. Then touch the **"Cast"** button only if what is displayed on the card accurately reflects your choice.
 - If changes need to be made after printing the Voter Paper Audit Trail, touch the **"Quit"** button to cancel the voting session. A poll worker will be signaled to assist you. You must return your spoiled paper audit trail folded to the poll worker in order to receive a new activation card to start the voting process over.

PUBLIC QUESTION TO BE VOTED UPON

BOND PROPOSAL QUESTION

The Board of Education of the Township of Washington in the County of Morris, New Jersey is authorized (a) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades at Benedict A. Cucinella Elementary School, Flocktown Elementary School, Old Farmers Road Elementary School, Walter J. Kossman Elementary School, and Long Valley Middle School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; (b) to appropriate \$28,809,494 for such improvements; and (c) to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$28,809,494. The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects.

The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$28,704,817 (consisting of \$3,306,220 for Benedict A. Cucinella Elementary School, \$4,806,860 for Flocktown Elementary School, \$2,361,813 for Old Farmers Road Elementary School, \$6,749,800 for Walter J. Kossman Elementary School, and \$11,480,124 for Long Valley Middle School). The projects include \$104,677 (consisting of \$94,090 for Benedict A. Cucinella Elementary School, \$0 for Flocktown Elementary School, \$10,587 for Old Farmers Road Elementary School, \$0 for Walter J. Kossman Elementary School, and \$0 for Long Valley Middle School) for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election.
