	The Board or Education of the West Morris Regional High School District, in the County of Morris, New Jersey is authorized: (a) to provide for renovations, alterations and improvements at Central High School and Mendham High School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furnishings and equipment, sitework and related work and costs; (b) to appropriate \$26,047,276 for such purposes and (c) to issue bonds of the school district therefor in the principal amount of \$26,047,276.					
	The final eligible costs of these projects authorized by this bond proposal and approved by the Commissioner of Education are \$23,480,321 (with \$10,550,579 allocated to Central High School and \$12,929,742 allocated to Mendham High School). The proposed improvements include \$1,282,838 allocated to Central High School and \$1,284,117 allocated to Mendham High School for elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects. The Board of Education is authorized to transfer funds among the projects approved at this election.

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

- Please read through the instructions completely. After inserting the card given to you by the poll worker, insert it into the card slot in the device to the right, cut corner of the card in the upper right.
- Touch YES or NO on the PROPOSAL to make your selection. Your selection will turn Green. To Change your selection, touch the Green Box again and it will de-select your choice. You may make a new selection.
- When you have completed voting and verified your selection, touch the Green "Print Ballot" button on the lower right side of the screen. A confirmation message will first be displayed to "Return to Ballot" or "Print".
 - To make any changes before printing the voter paper audit trial, touch "Return to Ballot".
 - · To proceed with printing the voter paper audit trail, touch "Print"
 - This will print your selection on the card and display it in the printer window for your review.
 - Review the card to ensure it represents your selection accurately. Then touch the "Cast" button only if what is displayed on the card accurately reflects your choice.
 - If changes need to be made after printing the Voter Paper Audit Trail, touch
 the "Quit" button to cancel the voting session. A poll worker will be
 signaled to assist you. You must return your spoiled paper audit trail folded
 to the poll worker in order to receive a new activation card to start the
 voting process over.
