As a result of legislation enacted into law, the State of New Jersey will be offering in-person early voting on a machine during a nine day period. In addition to providing early voting, registered voters will continue to have the option of voting by mail or in-person at their polling place on Election Day. There will be 8 early voting sites throughout Morris County. Electronic poll books will be used to sign-in voters. Poll workers will be available to assist all voters in using these devices. The early voting locations are listed below. Hours for early voting are Monday-Saturday, 10am to 8pm and Sunday 10am to 6pm. It doesn't matter where you live in Morris County - You can go to any of the 8 sites and conveniently cast your ballot on a voting machine.

Official General Election Sample Ballot

PUBLIC QUESTION

Shall the County of Morris amend the Morris County Open Space, Farmland, Floodplain Protection and Historic Preservation Trust Fund to include the purpose of stewardship of permanently preserved lands acquired for recreation and conservation purposes that are designed to restore or enhance its utilization for those purposes and allow the use of previously collected funds for those purposes?

INTERPRETIVE STATEMENT

A "YES" vote will permit the County of Morris to include natural resource management, habitat restoration and wildlife stewardship as eligible activities on permanently preserved land acquired for recreation and conservation purposes. These include projects that are designed to enhance or restore the land's utilization for those purposes as eligible activities funded as part of the Morris County Open Space, Farmland, Floodplain Protection and Historic Preservation Trust Fund. A "YES" vote will not increase the tax.

BALLOT QUESTION

Shall the Borough of Chatham establish a Length of Service Awards Program ("Program") for the Chatham Fire Department that serves the Borough in accordance with the following terms and conditions:

A. The Program shall provide for annual contributions to a deferred income account for each active volunteer member that meets the eligibility criteria and in accordance with the schedule adopted by the Borough of Chatham.

B. The proposed maximum annual contribution amount for a qualifying member is \$1,150, which the Borough may increase from time to time based on increases in the Consumer Price Index, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:14- 185(f).

C. The estimated annual cost of the Program is \$35,000

D. The estimated one-time cost of the Program for prior service is \$15,000.

Explanatory Statement

The Borough of Chatham seeks to create a Length of Service Program ("LOSAP") for members of the Chatham Fire Department who serve the citizens of the Borough of Chatham. The general requirements for a LOSAP are set forth in N.J.S.A. 40A:14-183 through 40A:14-194.1. The LOSAP would provide annual contributions to a deferred compensation program for all qualifying volunteer members of the Chatham Fire Department. Members would earn points for enumerated Fire Department-related activities and would qualify for a LOSAP contribution upon earning 135 points per calendar year. The proposed maximum annual contribution amount for each qualifying member is \$1150, and members will receive contributions as credit for up to five prior years of qualifying service. Based on 30 qualifying members, the proposed estimated annual amount to be budgeted for the LOSAP is \$35,000, along with a one-time cost for prior years of qualifying service of \$15,000. Program details may be found in the Ordinance adopted by the Borough Council, which is available for public inspection at the office of the Borough Clerk, 54 Fairmount Avenue, Chatham, NJ, between the hours of 8:00am and 4:00pm Monday to Thursday and 8:00am - 1:00pm Friday.

EARLY VOTING & ELECTION DAY

INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

1. Please read through the instructions completely. After receiving the Ballot Card given to you by the poll worker, insert it into the card slot on the device to the right, cut corner of the card in the upper right.

2. Touch candidate names and Questions YES or NO to make your selections. Your selection will turn Green. To change your selection, touch the Green Box again and it will de-select that selection. You may make a new selection.

3. To write-in a candidate, select the Write-In box, in the last column, across from the office you wish to write-in. A keyboard will appear. Type in the first and last name of the person of your choice. Touch "Accept". Your write-in choice will appear on the ballot.

4. When you have completed voting and verified your selections, touch the Green "Print and Review" button on the lower right side of the screen. A confirmation message will first be displayed to "Return to Voting" or "Print".
 - To make any changes before printing the voter paper audit trail, touch "Return to Voting".
- To proceed with printing the voter paper Ballot, touch "Print". This will print the candidates you have selected on the Ballot card and display it in the printer window for your review.

Review the Ballot card to ensure it represents your selections accurately. Then touch the "Cast Your Ballot" button only if what is displayed on the Ballot card accurately reflects your choices.

If changes need to be made after printing the Ballot card, touch the "Quit" button to cancel the voting session. A poll worker will be signaled to assist you. You must return your spoiled Ballot card folded to the poll worker in order to receive a new Ballot activation card to start the voting process over.
