As a result of legislation enacted into law, the State of New Jersey will be offering in-person early voting on a machine during a six day period. In addition to providing early voting, registered voters will continue to have the option of voting by mail or in-person at their polling place on Election Day. There will be 8 early voting sites throughout Morris County. Electronic poll books will be used to sign-in voters. Poll workers will be available to assist all voters in using these devices. The early voting locations are listed below. Hours for early voting are Tuesday-Saturday, 10am to 8pm and Sunday 10am to 6pm. It doesn't matter where you live in Morris County - registered voters can go to any of the 8 sites and conveniently cast your ballot on a voting machine.

4. When you have completed voting and verified your selections, touch the Green "Print and Review" button.

This is a PRIMARY ELECTION. Therefore you are confined legally to a choice of candidates for nomination within your own Political Party. The machine is so adjusted as to comply with the law, and will not permit you to vote in the Primary of more than ONE Political Party.
