


I am proud to present the 2026 Morris County Manual. The manual is published annually by the Office of the Morris County Clerk and is used extensively as a resource by government officials and county residents.



MORRIS COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE SERVICES

The Clerk's Office performs many important functions including election related duties, recording of property records and trade names, issuing photo identification cards and even operating as a passport acceptance facility. The following list includes some of additional services recently implemented by Morris County Clerk, Ann F. Grossi, that you may not be familiar with.

Please visit morriscountyclerk.org to access all of these services and more.

- **Property Alert Service** - A free service that allows users to register to receive automated email notifications whenever a document is recorded in their name. In addition, users may provide the municipality, block and lot of a specific property that they wish to receive notifications for. Please visit our website to find more information about how you can easily register for this beneficial service and protect yourself from fraud. The Property Alert Service can be accessed by visiting morriscountyclerk.org/services.
- **Clerk's Office Mobile App** - The free app provides a user friendly mobile experience to access all of our available services found on morriscountyclerk.org and is available for Android through the Google Play Store and for iPhone through the Apple App Store.
- **Online Scheduling for Notary & Passport Appointments** - The Clerk's Office website now offers the ability for users to schedule appointments for Notaries to take their Oath of Office and travelers to meet with a Passport Acceptance Agent and submit their applications for new and renewal passports. Users can simply enter some basic information and request a specific date and time through the automated system found at morriscountyclerk.org.
- **County Clerk Outreach Program** - County Clerk Ann Grossi is available for speaking engagements and outreach events. During her tenure, she has visited numerous clubs, assisted living facilities, veteran organizations and businesses to inform about the many functions and services offered by the Clerk's Office. She has also held many outreach events, bringing our passport, notary and ID card services "on the road" throughout Morris County. Anyone interested in scheduling an event may send an email to ccoutreach@co.morris.nj.us for more information.
- **Veteran Services** - The Clerk's Office is proud to offer FREE Veteran Photo ID Cards to Morris County veterans who present their discharge records. We will permanently record the document and return it to the veteran, who will be able to obtain a certified copy from us at any time in the future. The ID Cards can be presented to receive special discounts offered by businesses participating in the County Clerk's Operation Give Back Discount Program.




