#### INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

- 1. Please read through the instructions completely. Insert the ballot card into the card slot
- on the right of the device with the cut corner of the card facing the upper right.

  2. Touch candidate names to make your selections. Your selection will turn Green. To Towrite-in a candidate, select the Write-in box, in the last column, across from the office
   To write-in a candidate, select the Write-in box, in the last column, across from the office
- To write-in a candidate, select the Write-in box, in the last column, scross from the office you wish to write-in. A Revpoard will appear. Type in the first and last name of the person of your choice. Touch "Accept". Your write-in choice will appear on the ballot. When you have completed voting and verified your selections, touch the Green Pfinit Ballot" button on the lower right side of the screen. A confirmation message will first be displayed to "Return to Ballot" or "Interview".

   To make any changes before printing the voter paper audit trail, touch "Return to Ballot" or "Interview".
