JUN 4 As a result of legislation enacted into law, the State of New Jersey will be offering in-person early voting on a machine during a three day period. In addition to providing early voting, registered voters will continue to have the option of voting by mail or in-person at their

polling place on Election Day. There will be 8 early voting sites throughout Morris County. New electronic poll books will be used to sign-in voters. Poll workers will be available to assist all voters in using these new devices. The early voting locations are listed below. Hours for early voting are Friday-Saturday, 10am to 8pm and Sunday 10am to 6pm. It doesn't matter where you live in Morris County - registered voters can go to any of the 8 sites and conveniently cast your ballot on a voting machine.
