INSTRUCTIONS FOR VOTING

- Please read through the instructions completely. Insert the ballot card into the card slot on the right of the device with the cut corner of the card facing the upper right.
- Touch candidate names to make your selections. Your selection will turn **Green**. To change your selection, touch the **Green Box** again and it will de-select that candidate. You may make a new selection.
- To write-in a candidate, select the **Write-In box**, in the last column, across from the office you wish to write-in. A keyboard will appear. Type in the first and last name of the person of your choice. Touch **"Accept"**. Your write-in choice will appear on the ballot.
- When you have completed voting and verified your selections, touch the **Green "Print Ballot"** button on the lower right side of the screen. A confirmation message will first be displayed to **"Return to Ballot"** or **"Print"**.
 - To make any changes before printing the voter paper audit trail, touch **"Return to Ballot"**.
 - To proceed with printing the voter paper Ballot, touch **"Print"**. This will print the candidates you have selected on the Ballot card and display it in the printer window for your review.
 - Review the Ballot card to ensure it represents your selections accurately. Then touch the **"Cast"** button only if what is displayed on the Ballot card accurately reflects your choices.
 - If changes need to be made after printing the Ballot card, touch the **"Quit"** button to cancel the voting session. A poll worker will be signaled to assist you. You must return your spoiled Ballot card folded to the poll worker in order to receive a new Ballot activation card to start the voting process over.

<p>PUBLIC QUESTIONS TO BE VOTED UPON</p> <p>Bond Proposal Question No. 1</p> <p>The Board of Education of the Township of Montville in the County of Morris, New Jersey is authorized (a) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations and upgrades, and to construct classroom additions at Cedar Hill Elementary School and Valley View Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; (b) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations and upgrades, and to construct a classroom and multi-purpose room addition at Hilldale Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; (c) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations and upgrades, and to construct classroom and multi-purpose room additions at William Mason Elementary School and Woodmont Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment, new parking and any site work; (d) to appropriate \$53,002,289 for such improvements; and (e) to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$53,002,289.</p> <p>The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$10,799,338 (consisting of \$2,310,032 for Cedar Hill Elementary School, \$2,241,857 for Valley View Elementary School, \$1,716,819 for Hilldale Elementary School, \$2,128,186 for William Mason Elementary School and \$2,402,444 for Woodmont Elementary School). The projects include \$5,673,267 (consisting of \$0 for Cedar Hill Elementary School, \$0 for Valley View Elementary School, \$620,620 for Hilldale Elementary School, \$4,455,050 for William Mason Elementary School and \$597,597 for Woodmont Elementary School) for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). <p>EXPLANATORY STATEMENT</p> <p>At this election, the voters of the school district are being asked to consider both Bond Proposal Question No. 1 and Bond Proposal Question No. 2. As set forth above, Bond Proposal Question No. 2 will only go into effect if Bond Proposal Question No. 1 is also approved by the voters at this election.</p> <p>If both Bond Proposal Question No. 1 and Bond Proposal Question No. 2 are approved by the voters at this election, the Board of Education will be authorized: (a) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations and upgrades, and to construct classroom additions at Cedar Hill Elementary School and Valley View Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; (b) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations and upgrades, and to construct classroom additions and multi-purpose room additions at Hilldale Elementary School and Woodmont Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; (c) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations and upgrades, and to construct a classroom addition and a multi-purpose room addition at William Mason Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment, new parking and any site work; (d) to construct a security vestibule at Montville High School, Valley View Elementary School, William Mason Elementary School and Woodmont Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, furniture, equipment and any site work; and (e) to undertake various improvements, alterations, renovations, and upgrades to the HVAC systems at Cedar Hill Elementary School, Hilldale Elementary School, Robert R. Lazar Middle School, William Mason Elementary School and at Woodmont Elementary School, including acquisition and installation of fixtures, equipment and any site work, for a total cost of \$69,982,603, and will be authorized to issue bonds in an amount not to exceed \$69,982,603. The final eligible costs for the projects approved by the New Jersey Commissioner of Education are \$27,779,652 (consisting of \$5,503,292 for Cedar Hill Elementary School, \$2,379,200 for Valley View Elementary School, \$4,043,799 for Hilldale Elementary School, \$5,145,117 for William Mason Elementary School, \$5,812,904 for Woodmont Elementary School, \$4,540,740 for Robert R. Lazar Middle School and \$354,600 for Montville High School). The projects include \$5,673,267 (consisting of \$0 for Cedar Hill Elementary School, \$0 for Valley View Elementary School, \$620,620 for Hilldale Elementary School, \$4,455,050 for William Mason Elementary School, \$597,597 for Woodmont Elementary School, \$0 for Robert R. Lazar Middle School and \$0 for Montville High School) for school facility construction elements in addition to the facilities efficiency standards developed by the Commissioner of Education or not otherwise eligible for State support pursuant to N.J.S.A. 18A:7G-5(g). The State debt service aid percentage will equal 40% of the annual debt service due with respect to the final eligible costs of the projects.
