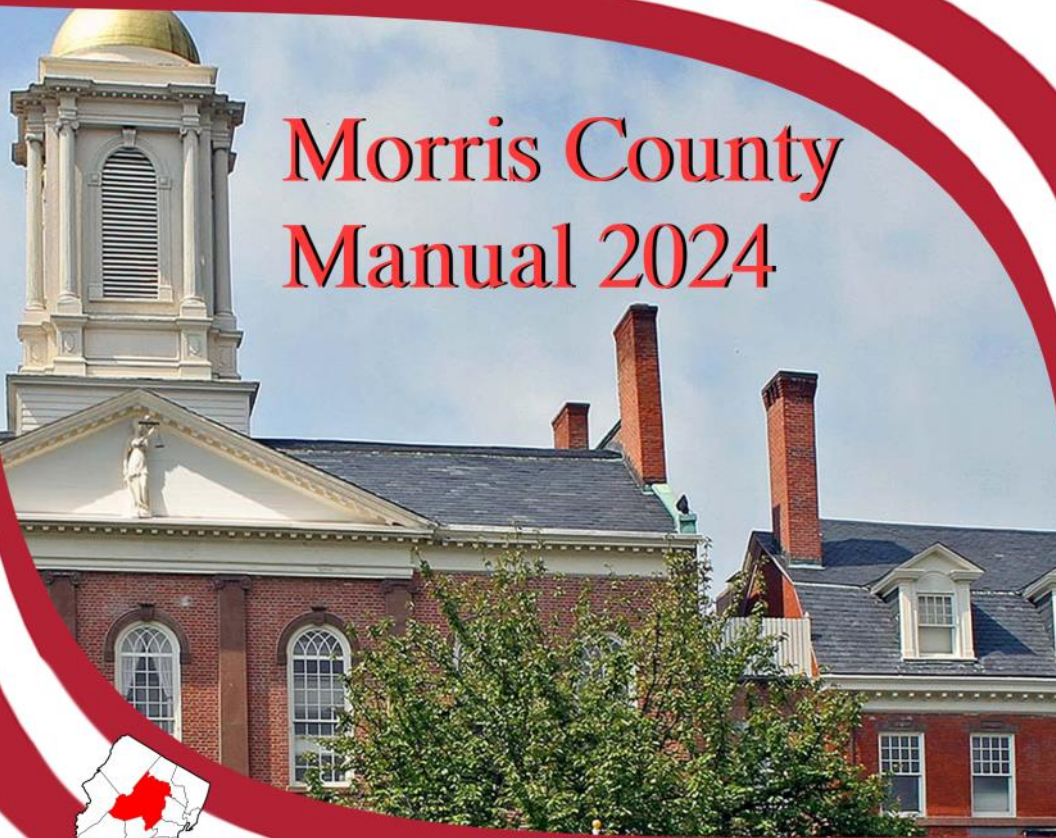

I am proud to present the 2024 Morris County Manual. This issue represents the 118th year that the manual has been published by the Office of the Morris County Clerk. While its design and content has changed throughout the decades, one thing has remained constant; the manual's objective to provide centralized resources for officials and residents concerning their government.

Established 285 years ago to perform the important function of recording every conveyance of property within the county, the Clerk's Office has progressed to provide an array of additional services. The Clerk's Office is unique in that we are open to the public and are proud to have helped up to 17,000 visitors a year who avail themselves of our services. Those services include but are not limited to election responsibilities, issuing Senior, Gold Star Family and Veteran Identification Cards, officiating marriages, accepting Notary Public registrations and administration of oaths, and processing U.S. Passport Books and Passport Cards through our award-winning certified Passport Acceptance Office, and numerous programs.

We are opening with advances in technology and office systems. Other advances are: 1) updated website providing streamlined and easy access to data; 2) a free email subscription, bringing the latest news to subscribers; 3) automated election results in various data formats for immediate electronic viewing; 4) a Social Media presence through Facebook, Instagram and Flickr accounts; 5) an Outreach Program bringing our services to you; 6) implementation of Daniel's Law; 7) a free Property Fraud Alert System; 8) the County Clerk's Mobile App, and 9) upgraded mission critical infrastructure for greater efficiency.

Additionally, the Clerk's Office is self-funded through the collection of state mandated fees and contributed more than \$9,600,000.00 in revenue directly to the county budget; thereby, offsetting the tax rate for 2024.

I congratulate the winners of the annual Morris County Manual Contest. Our 1st place winner is Charles Sagerer, a Senior at Boonton High School who will receive a \$500.00 scholarship. His design is featured on the cover of this manual. Our 2nd place winner of a \$200.00 scholarship is Kaden Montoya, a ninth grader from Morris Knolls High School. Our 3rd place winner of a \$100.00 scholarship is Lily Walsh, a Senior at Randolph High School.

As always, I hope the manual becomes a valuable resource for you and I and my staff look forward to serving you throughout the year.

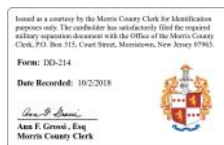
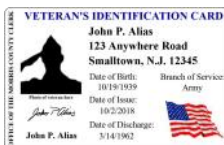

MORRIS COUNTY CLERK'S OFFICE SERVICES

The Clerk's Office performs many important functions including election related duties, recording of property records and trade names, issuing photo identification cards and even operating as a passport acceptance facility. The following list includes some of additional services recently implemented by Morris County Clerk, Ann F. Grossi, that you may not be familiar with.

Please visit morriscountyclerk.org to access all of these services and more.

- **Property Alert Service** - A free service that allows users to register to receive automated email notifications whenever a document is recorded in their name. In addition, users may provide the municipality, block and lot of a specific property that they wish to receive notifications for. Please visit our website to find more information about how you can easily register for this beneficial service and protect yourself from fraud. The Property Alert Service can be accessed by visiting morriscountyclerk.org/services.
- **Clerk's Office Mobile App** - The free app provides a user friendly mobile experience to access all of our available services found on morriscountyclerk.org and is available for Android through the Google Play Store and for iPhone through the Apple App Store.
- **Online Scheduling for Passport Appointments** - The Clerk's Office website now offers the ability for users to schedule appointments to meet with a Passport Acceptance Agent and submit their applications for new and renewal passports. Users can simply enter some basic information and request a specific date and time through the automated system found at morriscountyclerk.org/passports.
- **County Clerk Outreach Program** - County Clerk Ann Grossi is available for speaking engagements and outreach events. During her tenure, she has visited numerous clubs, assisted living facilities, veteran organizations and businesses to inform about the many functions and services offered by the Clerk's Office. She has also held many outreach events, bringing our passport, notary and ID card services "on the road" throughout Morris County. Anyone interested in scheduling an event may send an email to ccoutreach@co.morris.nj.us for more information.
- **Veteran Services** - The Clerk's Office is proud to offer FREE County Veteran Photo ID Cards to Morris County veterans who present their discharge records. We will permanently record the document and return it to the veteran, who will be able to obtain a certified copy from us at any time in the future.

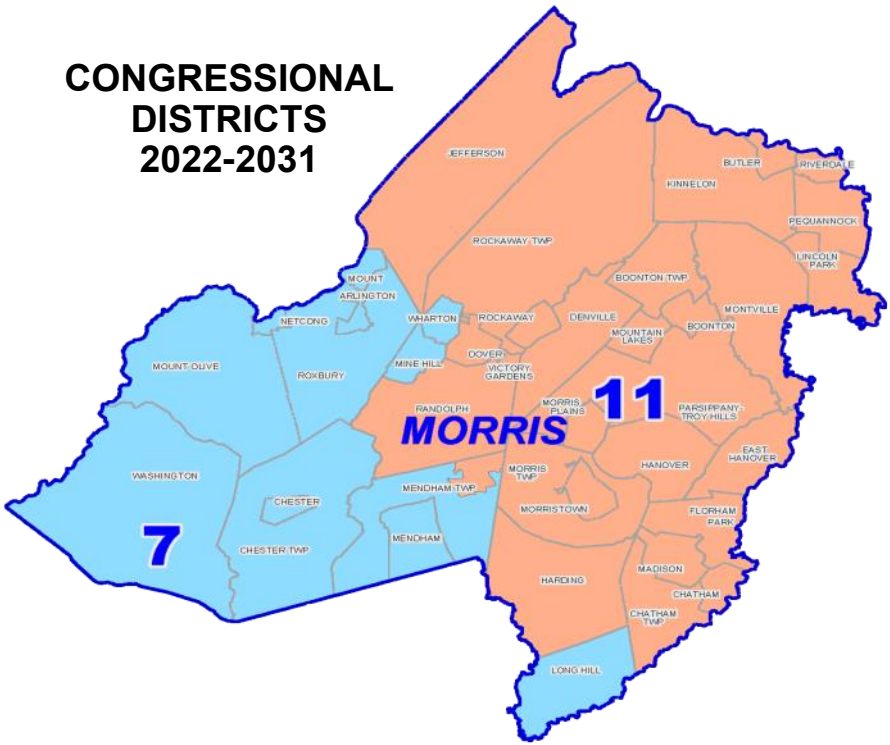

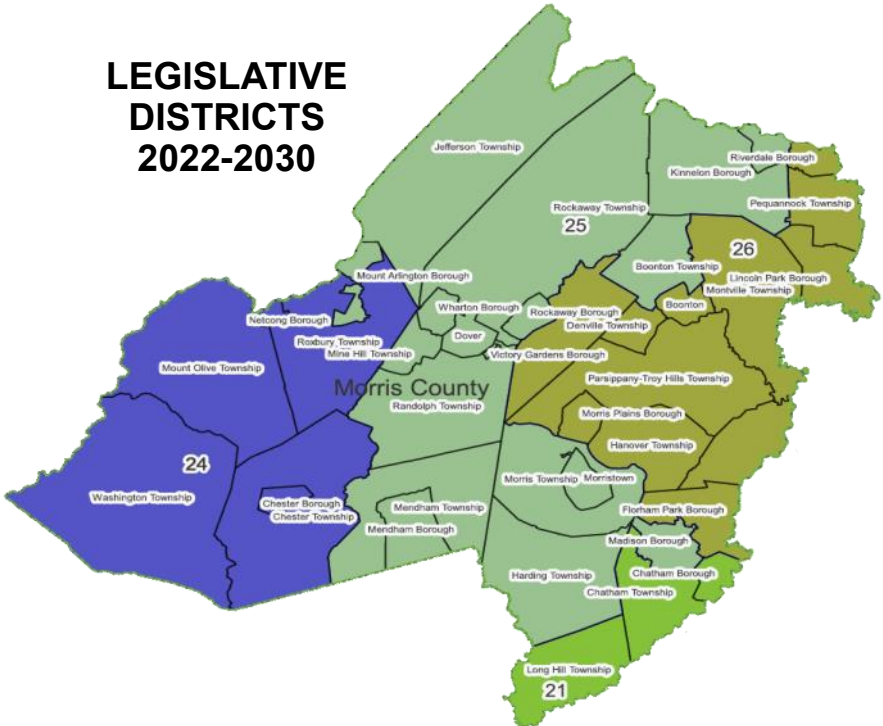
